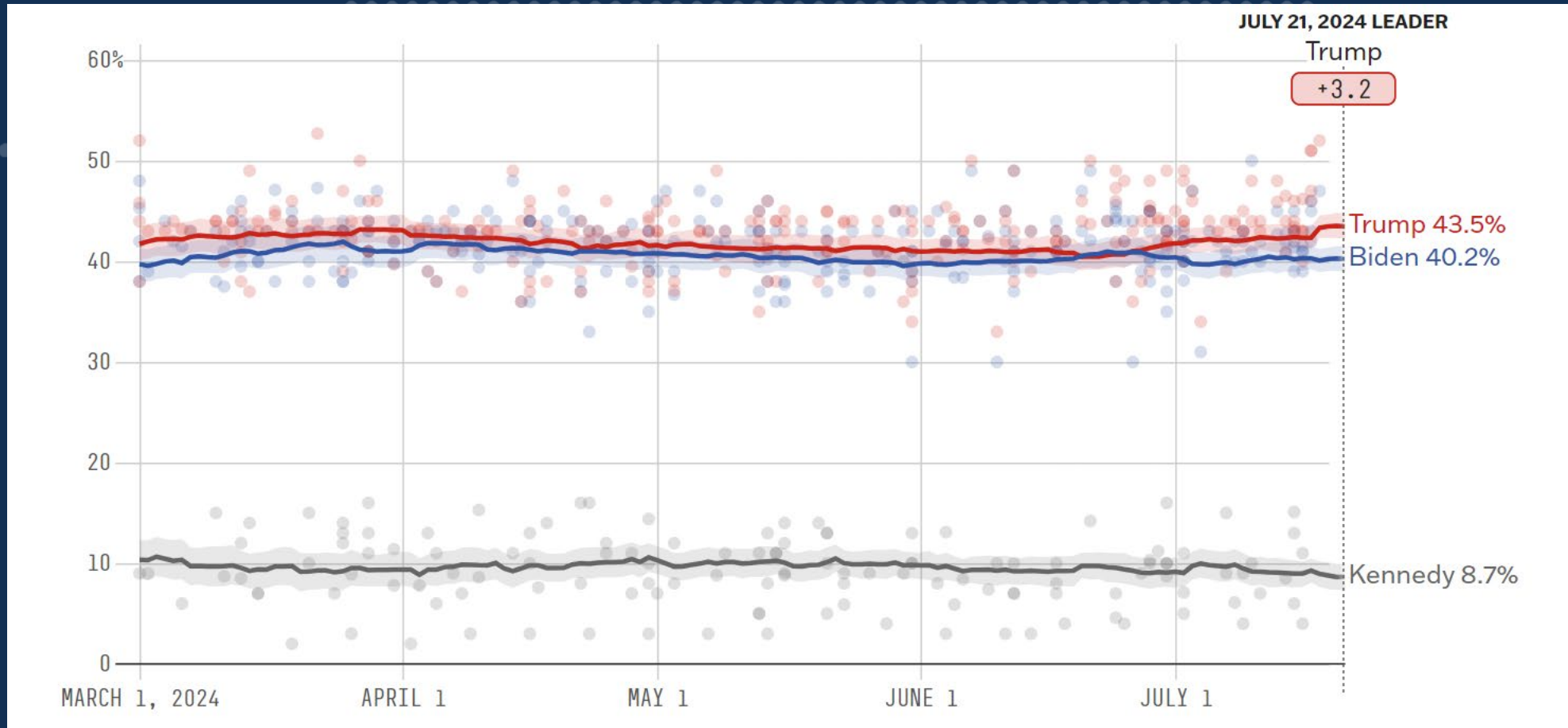

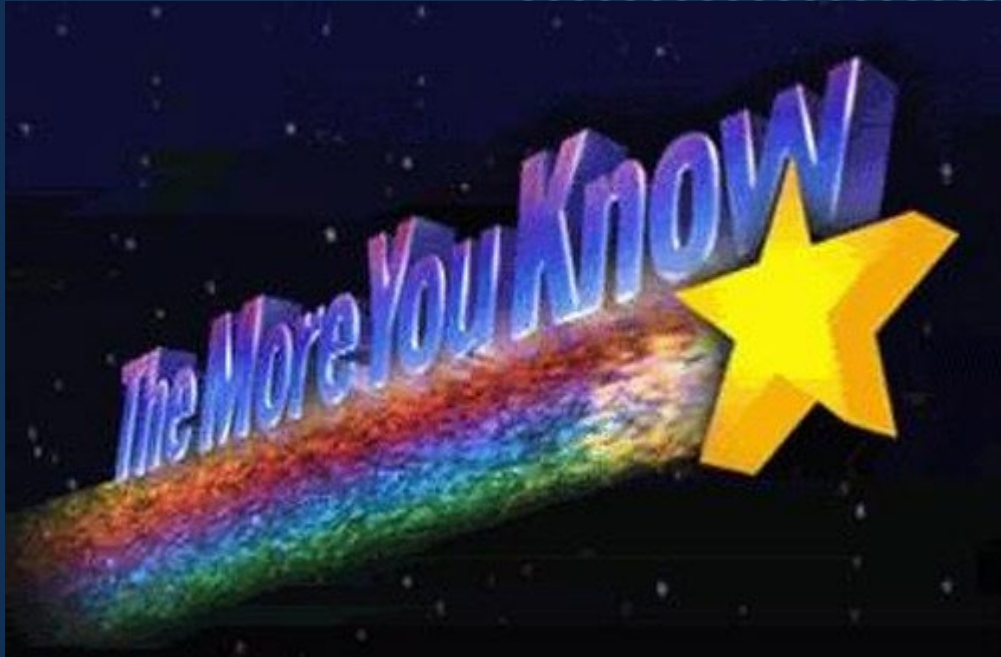


National Polls: Trump vs. Biden

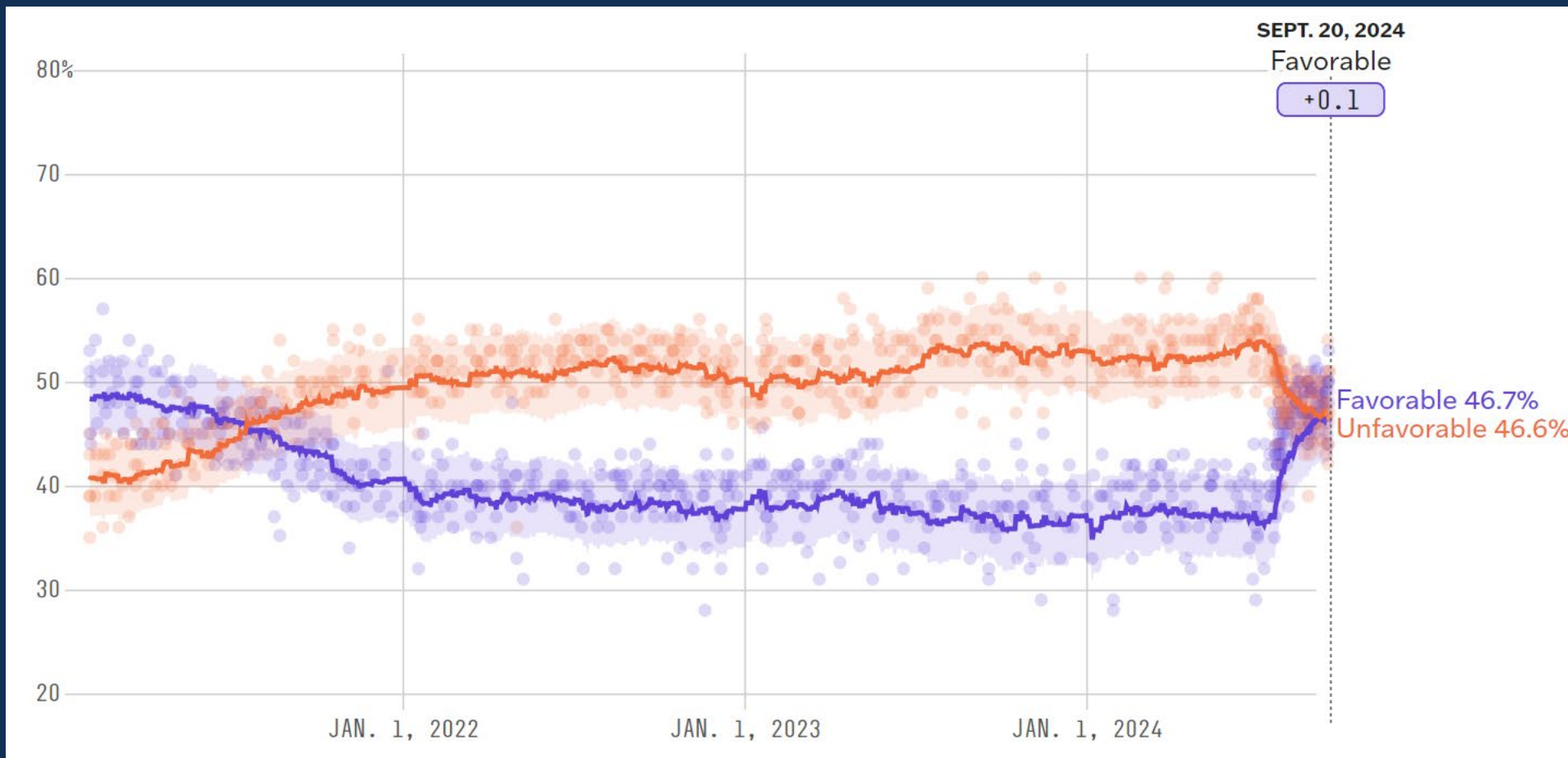

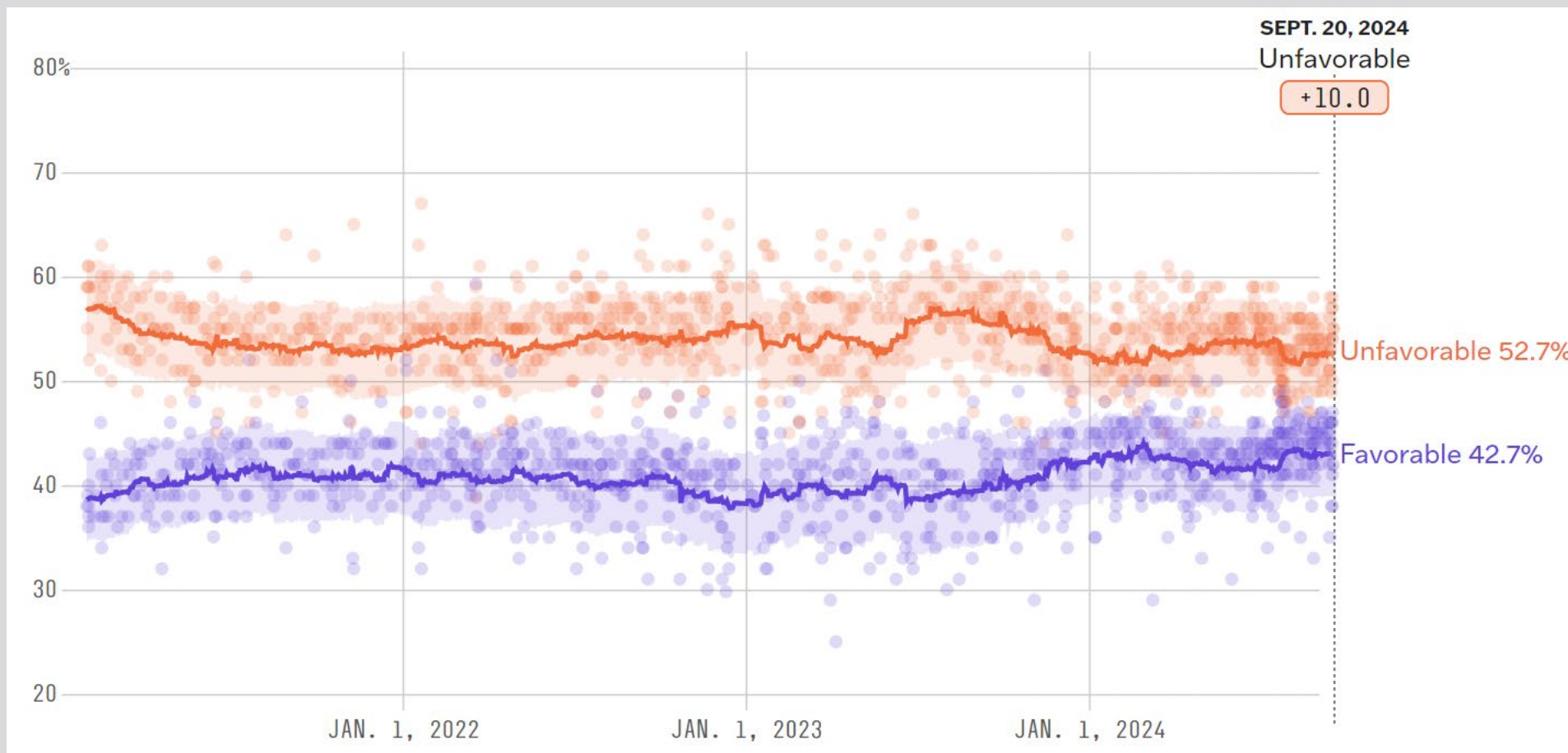
Kamala Harris' Image Rating

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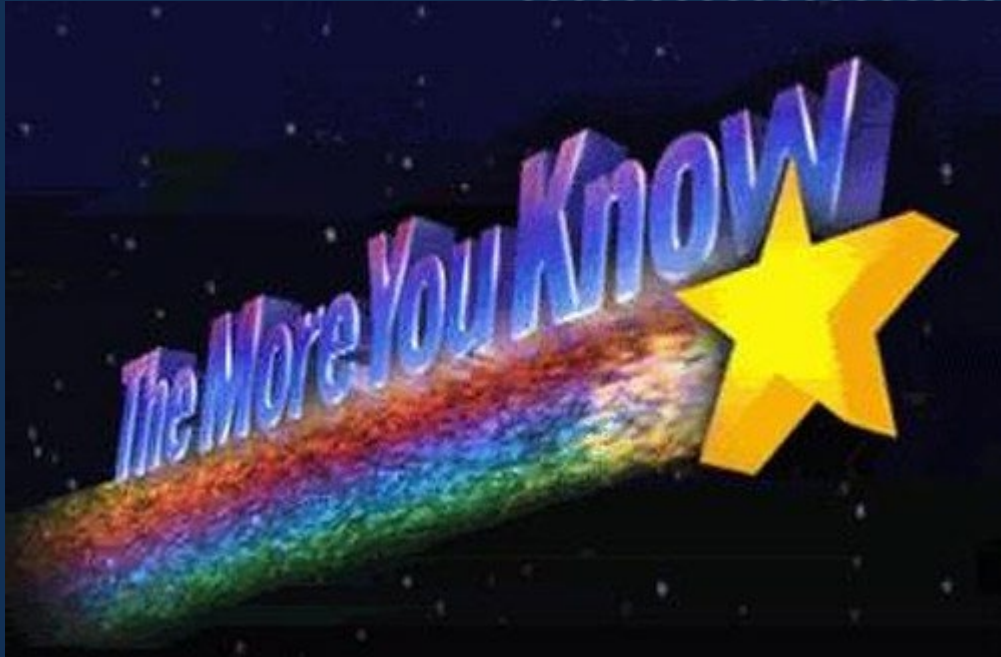
